



In an effort to maintain the safety, security, and privacy of students, staff and visitors, the Clinton Clinton Public Schools has determined that the operation of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also commonly referred to as drones, is prohibited by any persons on or over District property, including all buildings and grounds.

For the purposes of this policy, a UAV or drone is any aircraft without a human pilot aboard the device.

An exception to this policy may be made in specific cases where circumstances warrant, but must be approved in advance by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee. Approval must include an acceptance to follow all applicable Federal Aviation Administration regulations, including but not limited to FAA Advisory Circular 91-57A, FAA registration requirements, and all and subsequent guidelines and regulations as applicable.

Violations

Violators may be subject to disciplinary action, including immediate removal from school grounds and notification to the appropriate authorities.
